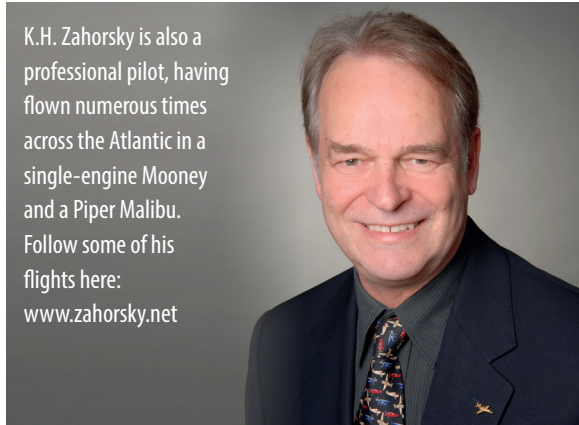

Scientist and visionary Karl-Heinz Zahorsky founded the company of LaserSoft Imaging (LSI) in 1986 and he developed the concept of the core product SilverFast in 1994. The company is based in Kiel, northern Germany, and a subsidiary for the North and South American markets was opened in Sarasota, Florida in 1997. Customers are private individuals, but also large image archives and museums such as MoMA and MET.

## Image processing tradition in Kiel

It is no coincidence that SilverFast was developed in Kiel, because the city on the Baltic Sea was already a center for communication devices and electronic reproduction technology in the 20th century. Thanks to the inventions of Rudolf Hell (1901-2002), the first Chromagraph scanners and ChromaCom image processing systems were developed. LSI is building on this tradition not only putting itself in the spotlight, but also the city of Kiel. Founder Zahorsky was early involved in the development of color management and image processing software for desktop computers. He worked with the companies of Hell, Apple and others. Today, LSI is regarded worldwide as a pio-
